Will There Always Be Enough Water ?

A female zebra and her foal enjoy the water in Kenya's Amboseli National Park, near Mount Kilimanjaro. *Amboseli* is sometimes said to mean "place of water" in the local Masai language, but today it more closely resembles its other meaning, "salty dust." As a result of unusual weather possibly related to global warming, the availability of water has decreased in recent years. When photographer Mitsuaki Iwago visited the park in July 2007 with his Olympus E-3 digital SLR camera, the sun-baked land stretched in all directions from the edge of a watering hole where animals crowded around, desperate to quench their thirst.
