How long will the water last?

Fed by groundwater that seeps down from nearby Mt. Kilimanjaro, the marshes of Kenya's Amboseli National Park provide water for thousands of animals, including elephants that can drink up to 50 gallons a day. To photographer Mitsuaki Iwago, returning to Africa in 2007 for the first time in a decade with his Olympus E-system digital SLR camera, it seemed that Kilimanjaro's once mighty glaciers were shrinking with each passing year. The sight troubled him, not just because of the potential loss of such a magnificent natural wonder, but because of the glaciers' importance to the animals living in the savannah below.
