Olympus Increases Support for COVID-19 Measures to 100 Million Yen

Tokyo, June 4, 2020 – Olympus Corporation (President: Yasuo Takeuchi) today announced its commitment to donate an additional 50 million JPY to support the COVID-19 global pandemic response, bringing its total support to 100 million JPY.

Earlier this year, as part of its response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Olympus donated approximately 50 million JPY worth of its products and services in China. The new commitment includes cash and in-kind donations of 50 million yen to support people most affected by COVID-19 around the world.
